FUND OBJECTIVE

The NWQ Fiduciary Fund (Fund), managed by NWQ Capital Management, is a diversified multi manager portfolio. The principal investment objective of the Fund is to produce attractive positive returns irrespective of market direction. This is achieved through active allocations to selected Australian equity fund managers that employ a variety of traditional and absolute return strategies. The Fund places emphasis on managers who demonstrate a rigorous and repeatable investment process that has delivered a strong track record.

This report contains performance figures for a Wholesale A Investor where a management fee of 0.50% p.a. and a performance fee of 5.00% (subject to performance hurdle and high water mark) have been deducted along with estimated ordinary expenses of 0.50% p.a. and assuming the reinvestment of distributions. Past performance is no guarantee of future performance.





STRATEGY CONTRIBUTION TO PERFORMANCE BEFORE NWQ FEES




COMMENTARY

 $The \ NWQ \ Fiduciary \ Fund \ (Fund) \ returned \ +1.05\% \ in \ June \ compared \ with \ the \ HFRI \ benchmark \ return \ of \ -0.04\%.$

Risk sentiment was generally positive in June. There was a temporary setback mid-month following a set of hawkish forecasts from the Fed that led investors to bring forward their expectations for interest rate increases. With US core inflation (all items less food and energy) currently running at an annual rate of 3.8%, its highest level since 1992, many are questioning the Fed's central narrative that inflation is 'transitory'. However, investor concerns were soothed by labour market data indicating the recovery was still ongoing and Fed Chair Powell's comments that a patient approach would be taken to scaling back monetary support. Equity markets rose in the US (+2.33%), Australia (+2.26%), and Europe (+1.70%) while they fell marginally in Japan (-0.08%). The Australian stock market was led by the Information Technology (+13.41%), Communication Services (+5.55%), and Consumer Staples (+5.33%) sectors with the Healthcare (-2.16%), Materials (+0.27%), and Financials (-0.19%) sectors lagging.

The Fund is constructed to be an alternative to the traditional balanced fund comprised of stocks and bonds. The Fund delivered a return of +14.11% for the financial year, outperforming the traditional balanced fund (+13.75%) and Australian bonds (-0.84%). The Fund's returns were achieved with a modest net exposure to the stock market and no direct exposure to the bond market. The Fund continues to present a compelling alternative to the traditional balanced fund construct.


