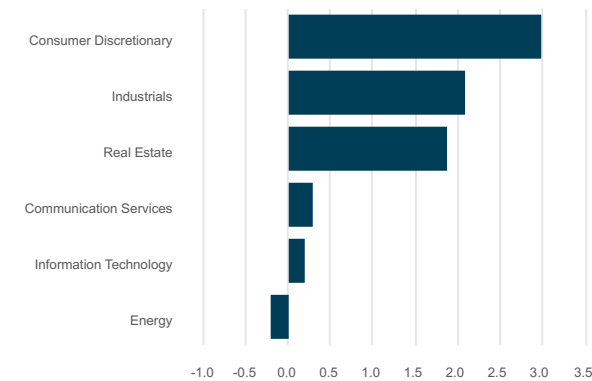
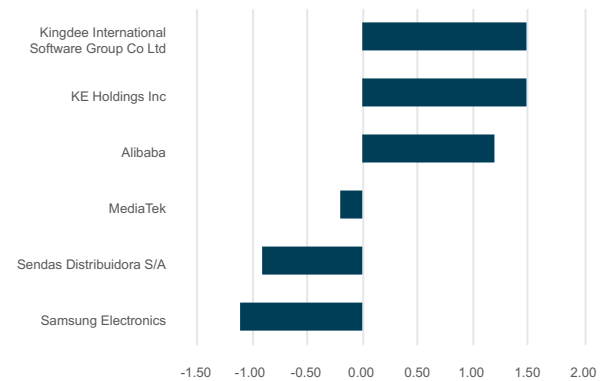

## Fund features

- Objective to achieve absolute returns in excess of the benchmark over the investment cycle (typically 3-5 years)
- The Fund invests in companies that are exposed to emerging markets or listed on emerging market stock exchanges.
- In the absence of finding individual securities that meet minimum risk-return criteria, cash may be held to maximum 25%
- Flexibility to hedge for risk management purposes:
  - Currency exposure of the underlying stock position (net short currency position not permitted)
  - Equity market exposure via exchange traded derivatives (limited to 10% of NAV)
  - Leverage not permitted
- This product is likely to be appropriate for a consumer seeking capital growth to be used as a small allocation within a portfolio where the consumer has a minimum investment timeframe of 5 years, and a high risk/return profile.
